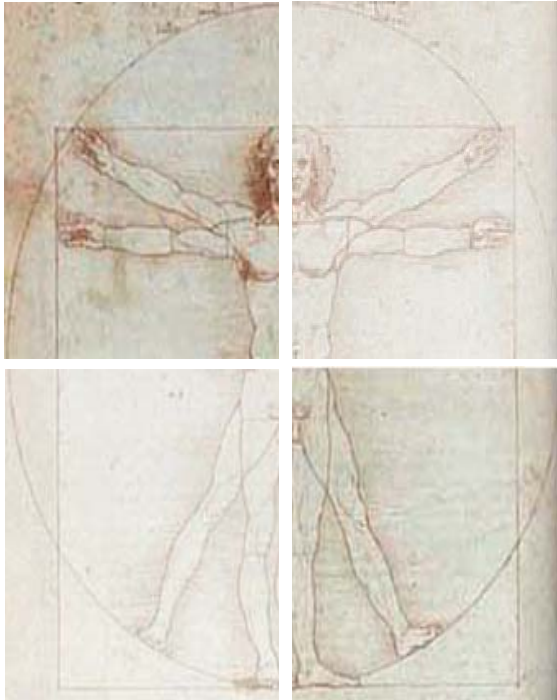

Certificate IV in Massage Therapy Practice

The Certificate IV in Massage course (HLT 40307) provides MCPT student graduates with an entry level qualification required to enter the Professional Massage Therapy & Health Care Industry.

This Course has a main focus on Therapeutic and Relaxation Massage Skills. It also provides a range of skills & practical tactile modalities, such as Swedish Massage, Deep Tissue, Sports Massage, Aromatherapy Basics and Fundamentals of Reflexology.

The Clinical Assessment is paramount which includes the history and principles of massage, and the use of anatomical and industry-specific terminology.

The Student Clinic component of the course provides invaluable hands-on workplace experience in a supervised clinic, allowing students to develop confidence and integration of various techniques as they learn to assess and treat their clients.

Upon successful completion of Certificate IV in Massage, graduates may register as a full member with a national massage association and obtain professional indemnity insurance & commence professional work.

Graduate students wishing to further their studies and to obtain provider numbers with various private health funds have an option to continue with an upgrade to Diploma of Remedial Massage.
