The CMT - Certificate Relaxation Massage (Relaxation) is a pre-requisite to our Accredited Courses.

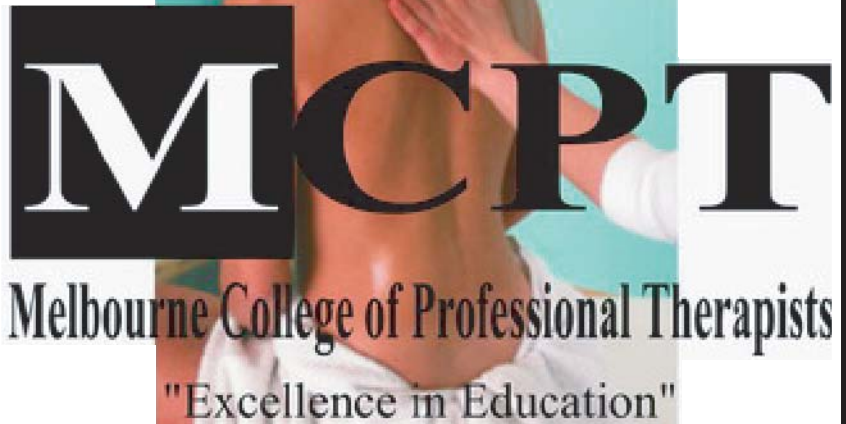
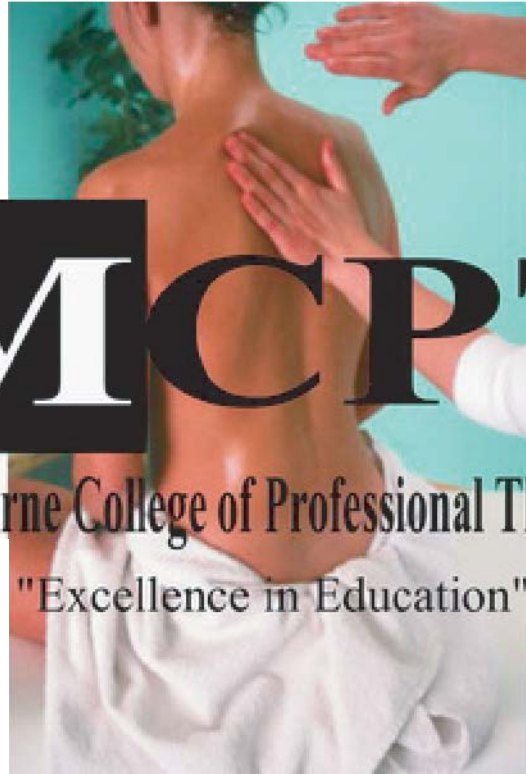
The CMT Course is a non accredited course that aims to create a massage practitioner with good career potential & foundation of skills that will lead to further study to advanced Courses that lead to professional work.
